

*Freedom of Information laws vary by state





Redefinition


Elementary School: Syncopation ("Hill and Gully")

- Concept: Syncopated Rhythms (upper elementary)
- SWBAT read and perform syncopated rhythms in context of a folk song (record in Noteflight)
- SWBAT create a rhythm composition using syncopated patterns
- SWBAT communicate and collaborate with classmates to engage in self- and peer critique
- Scale this activity up/down

Guiding principles for lesson design

- Think about playgrounds: free play, 'safety' & fences
- Enough structure to lead to the learning goal(s)
- Multiple opportunities and modalities for success
- Scaffolding including software & musical content
- Add grades/rubrics to the mix after students have had time to explore & experiment.
